

CSR YOUTH AWARDS

*Recognizing Youth Role Models in
Citizenship, Sustainability and Social Responsibility*



The **CSR Youth Awards** is a project of BCYF, co-sponsored by Deloitte Philippines, presented by Group Developers Inc. (GDI) supported by the Management Association of the Philippines (MAP) and the National CSR Educators Council (NCEC) recognizes outstanding young people who practice or who have initiated projects anchored on CSR 3.0 (Personal Social Responsibility). First awarded in 2015, the CSRYA recognizes students and young professionals, ages 39 years old and below, who are good role models in one of three categories of CSR 3.0: (1) Citizenship, (2) Sustainability and (3) Social Responsibility.

QUALIFICATIONS

- * Must not be over 39 years old at the time of the Awards Night the year of the Nomination
- * Must be a bonafide student in good standing of an institution or a working professional with proof of employment, work, or business.
- * The Nominee must prove leadership for at least 2 years, for their nominated C, S or R project/activity/business.
- * Initiatives must show a net positive impact to a group, community, or the country at large, that can be validated by proof, documentary evidence and referees. Initiatives must be replicable.
- * Must be willing to share expertise and experiences

REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed Application I Nomination Form
2. Curriculum Vitae / Organization Profile
3. Certificate of Enrollment (for students) Certificate of Employment (for employees)
4. Proof of business ownership or incorporation (for entrepreneurs)
4. Two Recommendation Letters
5. CSR Project Portfolio (photos and documents of volunteering experience I organizing projects with evaluation or assessment report, including financial statements submitted to the BIR and/or SEC, etc.
6. Signed Privacy Notice and Consent Form
7. A minimum 5-minute video explaining why the Nominee should be the Awardee.

Note: All submissions must be notarized. Financial must be signed by a CPA and has a "clean opinion".

The Decision of the Board of Judges is Final.
